The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 44.8 and 35.5 kDa after removal of the signal **Molecular Weight**

peptide. The apparent molecular mass of IL23A-hFc and IL12B-His is approximately 35-55 kDa

due to glycosylation.

The purity of the protein is greater than 95% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue Purity

staining.

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % 8% trehalose is added as protectants before Formulation &

lyophilization. Please see Certificate of Analysis for specific instructions of reconstitution.

Store at -20°C to -80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not

intended for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing). Storage & Shipping Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient

temperature

Interleukin-23 subunit alpha (IL-23 alpha) can associates with IL12B to form the IL-23 interleukin, a heterodimeric cytokine which functions in innate and adaptive immunity. IL-23 may constitute with IL-17 an acute response to infection in peripheral tissues. IL-23 binds to a heterodimeric receptor complex composed of

IL12RB1 and IL23R, activates the Jak-Stat signaling cascade, stimulates memory rather than

naive T-cells and promotes production of proinflammatory cytokines. IL-23 induces autoimmune inflammation and thus may be responsible for autoimmune inflammatory

diseases and may be important for tumorigenesis.


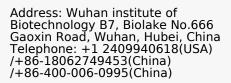


Figure 1.Human IL23A & IL12B Heterodimer Protein, hFc Tag & His Tag on SDS-PAGE under reducing condition.
